

ORDINANCE NO. 16-2017

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHOTWN, KENTUCKY
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 07-2017 AND REGULATING SOLICITATION ON THE
CROSSWALKS, STREETS, HIGHWAYS, INTERSECTIONS OR ROADWAYS
OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHTOWN**

WHEREAS, the City, out of concern for the safety of persons engaged in solicitation activities on City crosswalks, streets, highways, intersections or roadways as well as the safety of operators and passengers in motor vehicles, has heretofore addressed such solicitation activities within City limits, as evidenced by Ordinance No. 07-2000; and

WHEREAS, it is the judgement of the City Council that the benefit from the solicitation activities is outweighed by the safety risks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Elizabethtown, Kentucky, that:

SECTION 1

Ordinance No. 07-2000 shall be, and the same hereby is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2

No person shall stand or enter upon any crosswalk, street, highway, intersection or roadway within the City for the purpose of soliciting, receiving, or obtaining contributions. Any person violating this provision shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine not exceed the sum of \$100.

SECTION 3

This ordinance shall be effective December 1, 2017 upon adoption after second reading and publication in accordance with the requirements of applicable Kentucky law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Elizabethtown and/or her designate be and she is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this Ordinance.
